### **Victoire Champenois**

Policy officer Sustainable & Intelligent Transport, DG MOVE, European Commission

In July 2019, Victoire Champenois joined the Unit for Sustainable & Intelligent Transport in charge of intelligent transport systems, low emission transport and urban mobility in DG MOVE. She is responsible for topics related to multimodality for passengers and support to the implementation of the Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926 on the provision of EU-wide multimodal travel information services.

Before joining the Commission in 2001, she worked in the European Parliament as policy advisor and MEP assistant with responsibilities encompassing industry, energy and transport.

Her presentation will focus on the initiatives the European Commission will take to support further passenger multimodality and specifically multimodal digital mobility services. Planning and buying tickets for multimodal journeys can be cumbersome for travellers in the EU. Multimodal Digital Mobility Services (e.g. route-planners, ticket vendors) help to compare different travel options. This is recognised by the European Commission Strategy and Sustainable and Smart Mobility and key steps will be taken in that direction to implement the Strategy.
